



NCASA Budget Alert: \$60 Million in Cuts Proposed to Central Office Funding

June 23, 2009

Dear NCASA Member,

House and Senate budget negotiators agreed today to cut \$60 million from the central office allotment, which would eliminate half of the state funding for all LEA central office operations.

This proposal now goes to the co-chairs of the House and Senate Budget Conference Committee. All NCASA members should contact those co-chairs and all other House and Senate members immediately to urge them **NOT TO INCLUDE** this devastating cut in the final state budget.
